How to install the Carbon Phosphate Filter in 4 steps.

What is included:


- → Filter head
- → Filter body
- → 2 blue pipes & connections

Step 1: Installing the filter head.



- \rightarrow Identify an area suitable for installation.
- \rightarrow Mount the filter head vertically to a wall, cupboard, back or side.
- → Fix the filter head to the chosen area using the fixings provided. (Make sure the filter head is sufficiently robust enough to support the weight of the filter. This needs to be able to withstand forces applied at the filter installation and removal.)

Step 2: Installing the filter.




- → Rinse the filter cap connector with clean water. (This will help in lubricating the O ring.)
- → Twist the filter **anticlockwise** at the same time as pushing the filter up into the filter head until it stops.

Step 3: Connecting the system together.

Ensure the mains water supply is protected by an isolation valve.

Ensure that the mains water and electricity supplies are turned off.



- → Connect the ¼" blue pipes to the filter head inlet and outlet connections.
- → Measure the length of the pipe to reach each appliance and the water inlet connections and cut pipes to length.
- → Follow the diagram above, ensuring that the water flows in from the LEFT and out from the RIGHT.
- → Secure the pipes with NO kinks, sags or coils, so as not to present a hazard or stress to the connections.

Step 4: Flush the filter.

Turn on the mains water supply.

- → Check for leaks and turn on the mains electricity supply.
- → Flush for 60 seconds.
- → Turn the tap off for **30 seconds**.
- \rightarrow Turn on the tap and dispense the water for 60 seconds.
- \rightarrow The system is ready to use.
